Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group (NDPSG)	C Burrell N Permain J Chung (non-councillor) E Bartup (non-councillor G Catley (non-councillor)	The NDPSG is established to prepare the Neighbourhood Development Plan and report regularly to Council with recommendations for any actions and any expenditure.  Refer to NDPSG's ToR for detailed tasks, responsibilities, operating procedures and reporting.
Complaints Committee	H Hayes (Chair) A Farrar E Sharkey S Cobb	To follow the council's Complaints Policy Chairman to be appointed from four members. Chairman of Committee in conjunction with Council Chairman will convene any meeting in consideration of a complaint should this prove necessary following full Council consideration. Quorum = three members. Full delegated power to conclude complaint. Any minutes to be ratified prior to full Council notification.

## **Representing the Council**

<u>Public statements and representation</u>. Only the Chairman or in his absence the Vice Chair, can represent the PC to the media and/or any other authorities. This includes attending meetings. Meeting attendance is decided in advance by the Council

<u>Facebook and social media</u>. Councillor Cathy Burrell has sole authority to contribute to the PC's Facebook site. In the event of her absence, the Cllr El Sharkey will deputise.

<u>Planning issues</u>. The Planning Committee Chairman or in his/her absence, Andrew Farrar represents the PC on planning matters.
